Saudi Arabia is replacing oil in favor  
of renewables - KACARE steps up  
renewable energy drive

King Abdullah City for Atomic and Renewable Energy (KACARE) of Saudi Arabia stepped up its efforts and work in collaboration with a number of local and international organizations and institutions to speed up work on the renewable energy program.

According to Arab News:

RIYADH: Vision 2032 aims to replace 50 percent of Kingdom's dependence on traditional fossil fuels with ecofriendly atomic and renewable energy.

"We are working closely with a number of local and international organizations and have completed development of specifications for photoelectric solar plates, which is one of the key initiatives to develop a sustainable renewable energy sector in the Kingdom," a KACARE spokesman said on Thursday.

For more than a decade, the KACARE working group conducted research on the Kingdom's climatic conditions, analyzed data in connection with solar energy resources, and further utilized the outcome of indoor and outdoor laboratory tests to simulate conditions.
